EASY APRON SEWING PROJECT

Start making your own Easy Sewing apron today out of dollar store placemats! This is a great sewing project for beginners. Simple Step by Step Sewing tutorial on how to make na apron!

Materials

- Placemats (purchase larger size rectangle placemat)
- Fabric for ties (2 strips 5 inches by WOF
- Thread
- · Nylon Webbing

Instructions

- 1. Lay the placemats horizontally one above the other. Then fold the bottom placemat in half.
- 2. Slide the top placemat into the center of the folded placemat until the bottom edge reaches the fold.
- 3. Clip the edge of the placemats together where they meet.
- 4. Sew along the edges where the placemats come together. Sew a straight line up the placemats from the bottom to the top of the folded placemat to form pockets.
- 5. Cut a length of nylon webbing for your apron strap.
- 6. Fold the strap in half to find the center.
- 7. Clip the center to the top center of the apron, and add additional clips to hold it in place.
- 8. Sew along the top and bottom of the nylon webbing strap.
- 9. Flip it over and enjoy your new apron!
- 1. Optional: OR make two straps with coordinating fabric and attach to waist band of apron. Fold strips in 1/2, iron, fold each side to center, iron, sew the two completed strap together, adjust length so you can tie it around to front. Match center seam to center of body of apron and attach strap to apron.
